### Phillipa Puttlitz with BGC (formerly Boys and Girls Club) – Upstream

- Upstream is a prevention model, focusing on homelessness in youth by assessing risk factors, and offering case management supports
- Two projects in Canada right now in Kelowna and St. John's.
- All the elements of the project have been designed for our community. First survey in Kelowna was last year at KLO Middle School. Assessment with 220 Grade 8 students, 20 were connected to supports. NOT all of these kids would have ended up experiencing homelessness, but all have benefitted from supports around LGBTQ youth, food hampers, mental health resources, income assistance, rental subidies etc..
- This is the second implementation, letter to Grade 8 parents September 21<sup>st</sup>, and survey on October 6<sup>th</sup>.
